- Democracy: rights and responsibilities - taking part in elections, equal rights, making rules

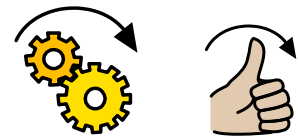
LEISURE AND RECREATION

- Health Action Plan - Becoming aware of own health needs, looking after yourself and providing health information



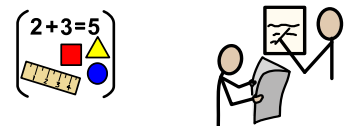
Functional Skills

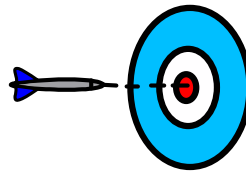

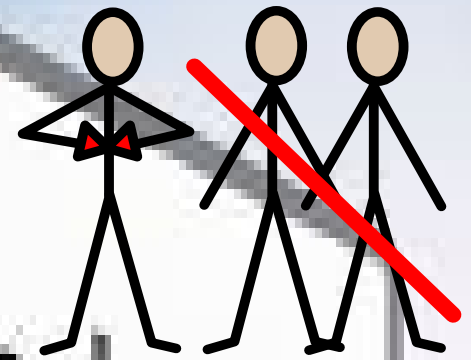
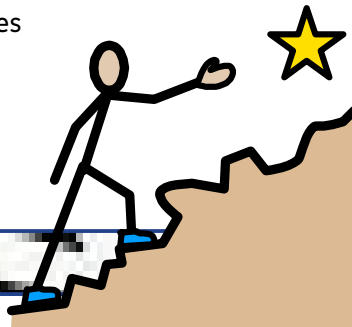
CAREERS EDUCATION & GUIDANCE / POST SCHOOL PLANNING
