# **Pupil Progress dialogues 2021- 2022**

*“Our overriding assessment is based on teacher judgements through professional conversation, dialogue and scrutiny, backed up with evidence on Earwig.”*

As we have a whole school child-centred approach, it is clear that no two children can be assessed and compared against the same outcomes.

We have introduced Pupil Progress dialogue meetings to enable us to monitor the achievements / progress of each child in each class against clear and challenging teacher expectations which will be based on each pupils starting point and future goals, dreams and aspirations

The Deputy Headteacher and Data Manager met all teachers / class leads over a few weeks at the end of the Spring term 2022 ( March 2022)

Teachers were able to select a date for the meeting , giving themselves up to two weeks notice and preparation time.

The meetings were a mixture on online and face -to-face

Teachers were asked to provide copies of all their pupils' Individual Learning Plans (ILP's) and the Deputy and Data manager spent time looking on Earwig for evidence to support the pupil's achievements and progress, compared to the ILP statements made.

The meeting was to enable professional dialogue to take place, discussing each individual pupil and the achievements made over the school year so far - using evidence from Earwig and teacher knowledge and judgements. During the meeting pupils' achievements and targets were discussed in depth. If it was deemed that a child was not making sufficient teacher expected achievements this was documented and clear next steps and actions were recorded to show how successful achievement by next term could be reached.

The next set of meetings took place in the last half of the Summer term 2022

At these meetings overall progress and achievements of each pupil was reviewed and discussed, with teachers giving a judgement in whether or not their expected progress for each individual had been reached
