


94 responses were received in total from parents and carers, which is an increase on last year's 53 respondents. Parents/carers were invited to complete the survey during parents evening and provided with iPads to do so. Parents/carers were also sent letters explaining how to complete the survey online, should they not wish to complete during parents evening, alongside a QR code/direct website link sent via Parent Hub.

The Statements Considered....

The statements were taken from Osted's 'Parent View' website. They were presented to parents/carers of students at Heltwate School during our November Parents' Evening, in the form of an online survey.

Result Break Down

Results were broken down into areas within Heltwate School to identify where improvements could be made.

Many parents within Lower School classes, and some Rainbow 1 respondents selected 'Don't Know' to a number of questions. This could be attributed to their child only attending the school for a matter of weeks and not having experience of the way Heltwate operates as yet.

Groups were broken down as follows:

Lower School Classes: Lilac, Lavender, Pink, Purple, Blue and Jade groups. (60 students)

These classes are aged from reception to year 6, catering for a range of SEND

Rainbow Rooms: Rainbow 1, Rainbow 2, Rainbow 3, Rainbow 4 and Rainbow 5 groups. (41 students)

These classes are aged from reception to year 13, catering for students with ASC.

Upper School Classes: Yellow, Orange, Green, Amber and Coral groups. (48 students)

These classes are aged from Year 7 to year 10, catering for a range of SEND


St George's Site: Saffron , Ruby, Olympic College 1 and 2 groups. (30 students)

These classes are aged from Year 10 to year 14, catering for a range of SEND


The initial question in the survey ask respondents to identify which class their child was in, which enabled us to group data effectively.

Parents from some classes were more responsive than others, so the data does not represent the opinion of all parents/carers with students at Heltwate School.


Q1 Which class is your child in?





However, 2 parents said that they 'didn't know', (parents/carers of students new to the school). 1 parent said that their child didn't feel safe, but the parent involved has been identified and concerns raised by these individuals are currently being addressed.








Last year's overall result.
