Follow a tasty morsel as it makes its way through your digestive system, helped by some mouth watering saliva! And don't forget the importance of good hygiene – at both ends!

And whilst we're talking business, could you recognise an animal just by its poo? Are you brave enough to take the challenge?

In our topic sessions the students will be learning all about their bodies and what they can do in order to stay fit and healthy. Students will explore their teeth, identifying the four types and the purpose of each as well as carrying out experiments. The digestive system will be studied and students will be learning about what changes people could make to their life styles to improve their health.

Literacy

This term the focus is on developing functional skills in English. The English functional skills qualifications are aimed at improving students' confidence and fluency in English. The aim is to focus on practical skills to get the most out of education, work and everyday life and to help them function more confidently, effectively and independently.

Numeracy

Data handling is the focus for Spring Term 1. We will be looking at extracting information from a range of data sets and comparing results. The students will have chance to create their own data and analyse the results. After February half term, the focus will be on measure including weight, capacity, length and height. The lessons will be practical and engaging as well as relating to real life situations.

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Employability

This term the Unit focus is 'Health and Safety in the Work Place'. This term, students will understand why it is important to follow health and safety instructions in the workplace, know the school's fire procedure, how to identify hazards and follow health and safety procedures.

D of E

This term we will be completing the Skills Section of the Bronze DofE Award. The students will be taking part in a 10 week First Aid programme 'Heartstart' giving them essential skills to be able to help someone who is ill or injured.

Home Management

The topic for this term is 'Household Cleaning'. The students will be taking part in physical household tasks, understanding the equipment and products required to clean a home and when certain jobs need to be done.

PSD

Our focus in Personal Social Development for the Spring Term is 'Managing Own Money'. We will be looking at income and expenditure and identifying examples of these, separating them into wants and needs. The students will create a budget plan as part of an enterprise project to make some money for their class. They will be learning about money and paying for items and activities. This will include purchasing ingredients to make their own lunch and taking part in a leisure activity. Students will learn about spending and saving by visiting a local bank.
