Numeracy

For this term we will be focusing on measuring, weighing and volume and capacity. During the second half term we will be focusing on ordering, time and numbers in the environment. Throughout the term we will continue to work on our adding and subtracting. Although we cannot go to the shops this term we will be handling money at times as well.

Literacy

During the Autumn term we will be focusing on writing and reading short sentences. We will also follow and write instructions. The students will learn woodland vocabulary and write woodland fact files. We will be focusing on the story 'Red riding hood' describing the characters, retelling the story through role play and asking questions.

Science

This term we will be identifying and naming a variety of common woodland animals, identifying living and dead things in a woodland, labeling a flower and identifying garden plants.

Geography

This term we will be learning to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features. Students will be making their very own woodland map to showcase.

Music

In music we will be learning to create movement in response to music. Students will play to the beat of a woodland song whilst walking through the forest. We will also be participating in a 'X factor style' classroom based assembly in which we will be performing 'Everybody goes surfing'. We will be practising as much as possible in the hope to win!



DI

In our cooking lessons we love to relate our cooking to the topic of the term whilst teaching the students to prepare and make fun things to eat. The students will weigh the ingredients and learn some important life skills. Please find the list of what we have planned to make: Apple crumble, fairy cakes, squirrel cookies, donut hedgehogs, toad stall cupcakes, flower sandwiches, bear toast, fairy bread, cheese swirl logs and cheese tree scones. We will also be cooking halloween, bonfire night and christmas themed treats as well.

Art

This term students will be out and about collecting materials to learn about their sensory properties. They will use those materials to make woodland crown, woodland creatures and tree bogarts.

PSHE

This term we will be learning about personal hygiene, how to wash our hands and clean our teeth. The children will be learning to recognise different personal hygiene products that they could buy in the supermarket.

RE

In RE we will be learning all about Hinduism. The children will listen to the story Rama and Sita, they will use their literacy skills to retell and role play the story. We will also be learning about the different festivals that Hindus celebrate including Diwali.

PE

PE will be taught by external coaches. We will be practicing our core skills and learning to play games such as hockey.
