

Requirement: Online reporting

Schools must publish brief details of their summer school on their website by the end of October 2021. This should include the amount of funding received and a breakdown of how it was spent.

Heltwate Summer School.

Theme: A Celebration of the UK. A day dedicated to each of the countries, before a celebratory visit to the seaside/seaside fun in school to round off the week.

<u>When:</u> The week ran from Monday 26th July - Friday 30th July, across both Mainsite and St George's site.

Who: All students in transition years, (6/7/9) were invited to the scheme, in response to the Covid pandemic and missed opportunities with regards to transitioning into new year groups/school settings. A total of 66 students were offered places, with 39 accepting.

What: A wide range of activities were offered, including the following:

- Transitional activities (such as meeting teachers or a tour of the school)
- Additional subject support, such as English, Maths and Science
- Sports-based activities, such as team games
- Arts-based activities, such as drama and crafts
- Wellbeing-based activities, such as team building, 'getting-to-know-you' exercises and mindfulness
- Trips to the local playpark, Forest Schools and the seaside
- Communication support, including PECs and sensory sessions
- Fun and games, including an inflatable play afternoon
