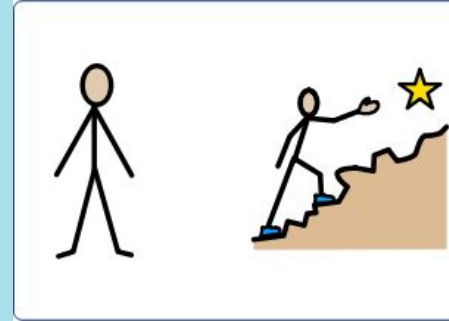
KS5 Curriculum

They are encouraged to think about what key skills they need for their future beyond Olympic College.</p> <p>Pupils entering our KS5 will be assessed as to which curriculum best suits their individual needs. This will be based on academic and soft skills assessments. All of our pupils at KS5 have been at Heltwate main site for their KS4 curriculum.</p> <p>Pupils follow an individually mapped curriculum route which is bespoke to their academic abilities. 













Other Information

- Non-uniform – students can wear their own clothes
- Transport to St. George's
- Travel Training – Bus Pass
- Bursary (depending on meeting criteria)
- 5 day provision
- College hours / term times same as school hours
- Lunch on site (cooking, packed lunch, still eligible for Free School Meals)
- Speech and Language Therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy programmes will continue
- Visual and Hearing Impairment service involvement will continue
