



They are encouraged to think about what key skills they need for their future beyond Olympic College. Pupils entering our KS5 will be assessed as to which curriculum best suits their individual needs. This will be based on academic and soft skills assessments. All of our pupils at KS5 have been at Heltwate main site for their KS4 curriculum. Pupils follow an individually mapped curriculum route which is bespoke to their academic abilities. 



- Visual and Hearing Impairment service involvement will continue














Where do Olympic College students move on to?
